QURBAN WITH GLOBAL EHSAN RELIEF

This year's Qurbani programme was Global Ehsan Relief's largest ever, alhamdulillah. A total of 4,295 animals were sacrificed and their meat distributed to poor Muslims families in 33 different countries.

Over 290,000 beneficiaries benefitted from your generosity. Thanks to you, the blessings of Eid reached the poor, the orphaned and the displaced. For many of them, it was the first time that they were able to enjoy meat this year!

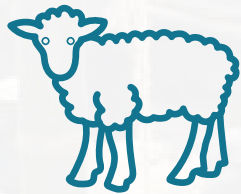
Figure above is the total amount spent for this year's Qurban Relief.

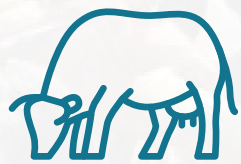

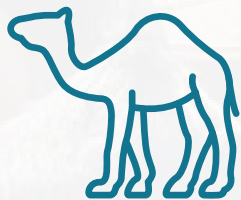

This ensures sustainability and the selection of non-diseased animals.

A SELECTION & PROCUREMENT

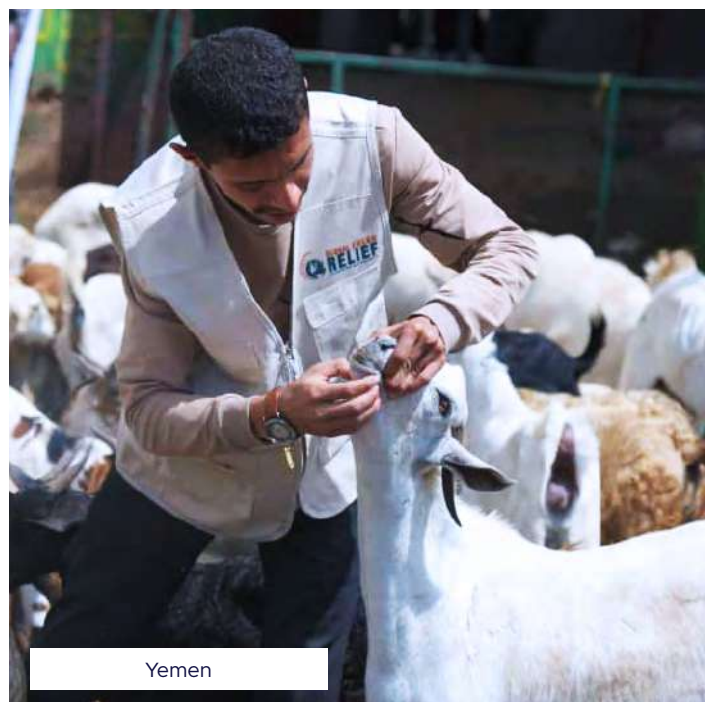
Our teams and partners in each countries visit local farms to hand-pick the livestock that will be slaughtered a few weeks prior to Eid al-Adha. They will examine the animals and ensure that only the healthiest ones are chosen for the sacrifice.

B SLAUGHTER & PACKAGING

The animals were sacrificed at a local mosque, courtyard or slaughter house and the meat was weighed and packed into 1-2kg packets.

C DISTRIBUTION

The packed meat will be delivered to the beneficiaries' villages or camps, and distributed accordingly. Our beneficiaries include the poor, needy, orphans, widows, and refugees.

YOUR QURBAN IN ASIA

The joys of Eid were brought to hundreds of thousands of families across Asia this year. The largest Qurbani programme in the region took place in India's West Bengal region, where 265 cows were sacrificed. The meat here was distributed to hundreds of poor Muslim villages.

The next largest programme was for Rohingya refugees stranded in Cox Bazar, Bangladesh who benefitted from 138 of your sacrificed animals. Thousands of refugees living in camps in the country's north-west border regions were given Qurban meat to enjoy, alhamdulillah.

Over in Sri Lanka, 61 cows and goats were sacrificed to feed hundreds of families in Kinniya and Trincomalee. Alhamdulillah, a further 3,000 families in mountainous regions like Pakistan, Afghanistan and Kashmir were also given your Udhiyyah.

Thousands of miles east, in Bangladesh, 34 animals were sacrificed and its meat distributed to poor families. And across the border in Myanmar, 10 large cows and goats fed 1,500 families, many of whom were Rohingya Muslims in Arakan.

In the Far East, a large programme in the South Philippines, Cambodia and Aceh, Indonesia saw Qurban meat distributed to hundreds of families in poor fishing villages.

YOUR QURBAN IN MIDDLE EAST

In response to war and hunger, Global Ehsan's largest programme in the Middle East came in Yemen. Alhamdulillah, over 395 animals were sacrificed here, feeding thousands of families across Taiz and Aden.

Further north for the Syrian Refugees, a total of 99 animals were sacrificed in Syria's Idlib province and in refugee camps in Jordan and Turkey. While 39 animals were sacrificed in besieged Gaza. The meat of these animals brought smiles to thousands of displaced, orphaned and widowed families. And in Iraq, Udhiyyah was provided to over 100 displaced families in Mosul and in the Anbari town of Ar Ramadi, alhamdulillah.

YOUR QURBAN IN AFRICA & EUROPE

Over 3,100 animals were sacrificed across the African continent this year. Qurban programmes took place in Cameroon, CAR, Somaliland, Somalia, Malawi, Ethiopia, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, Sudan, Chad, Burkino Faso, Niger, Kenya and Mali.

The largest programme was in Cameroon, where 2035 goats were sacrificed, feeding thousands of families in the poor central districts. Further north, 415 animals were sacrificed and given to displaced families in Somalia and Somaliland where there are still over half a million people still living in refugee camps.

Across the continent in West Africa, almost 500 animals were sacrificed for poor Muslims in Sierra Leone's Bo district, the central regions CAR, Chad and Malawi. And in the deserts Mali, Burkina Faso, Sudan over 150 families were able to enjoy the meat from the sacrifices of 12 cows. In East Africa – Kenya, Ethiopia and Tanzania were given 6 cows and 28 goats.

Lastly in Albania, 4 sheeps were sacrificed, feeding poor and orphaned families for the days of Eid, alhamdulillah.
