01 MESSAGE FROM CEO

My Dear Friends & Supporters,

2020 has been a tough and challenging year for all of us...without a doubt. With the whole world facing a pandemic and lockdowns, we feared the worst for our organisation's progress and sustainability. But alhamdulillah, with your tremendous support and the hard work of my GER team members worldwide – it turned out to be an amazing year of progress and development.

Despite the challenging circumstances of 2020, I am happy to be able to say that Global Ehsan Relief has risen far above and beyond my expectations. In this report, you will see how our generous donors and hard-working team overcame obstacles and reached new milestones providing aid to the needy in Singapore and around the world.

The total number of donations we received soared from 8,000 in 2019 to nearly 21,000 in 2020, with 90% of them coming from online. Because of your generosity and willingness to adapt, we managed to surpass our targets for the year, including those for Ramadhan and Qurban. In total, we disbursed more than \$3 million with 40 projects spread over 30 countries. Globally, we managed to distribute aid to refugees and needy communities around the world with the help of our trusted partners.



I am also happy to report that our donors have enabled us to sponsor 750 orphan children worldwide, up from 300 the previous year! As our core project, and the very reason this organization was founded, orphans have a very special place in our hearts.

To expand the range of our support for them in 2021, we plan to build schools for orphans and other needy children in Aceh, Pakistan, Gujarat, Jordan, and Syria by the end of the year, and achieve 1,000 sponsored orphans before Ramadhan, insyaAllah.

With travel bans keeping us grounded, we turned our focus inwards to our local projects and succeeded in helping more than 300 underprivileged Singaporeans in 2020. We plan to continue developing these projects and expanding them to include more needy communities in Singapore, such as those with disabilities.

All of these blessings are a heart-warming reminder that we are supported by people with the utmost compassion and humanity, who are willing to help the most vulnerable members of society despite their own struggles. It's been a bumpy road throughout the year, and 2021 will no doubt bring its own set of challenges as the pandemic continues to ravage the world, on top of existing conflicts and problems. However, this will not deter us from our mission of providing aid to the most vulnerable members of society.

I would like to thank our team members for their resilience and perseverance in overcoming the obstacles of the previous year, and our generous donors who have entrusted us to fulfil their amanah and helped us reach even more beneficiaries than before. We have achieved some amazing milestones together, and we hope to achieve many more this year, insyaAllah.

May Allah accept all of our work and all our donors' contributions, and may He ease the way for us all, ameen.

CARE FOR ORPHANS

ORPHANS SPONSORSHIP

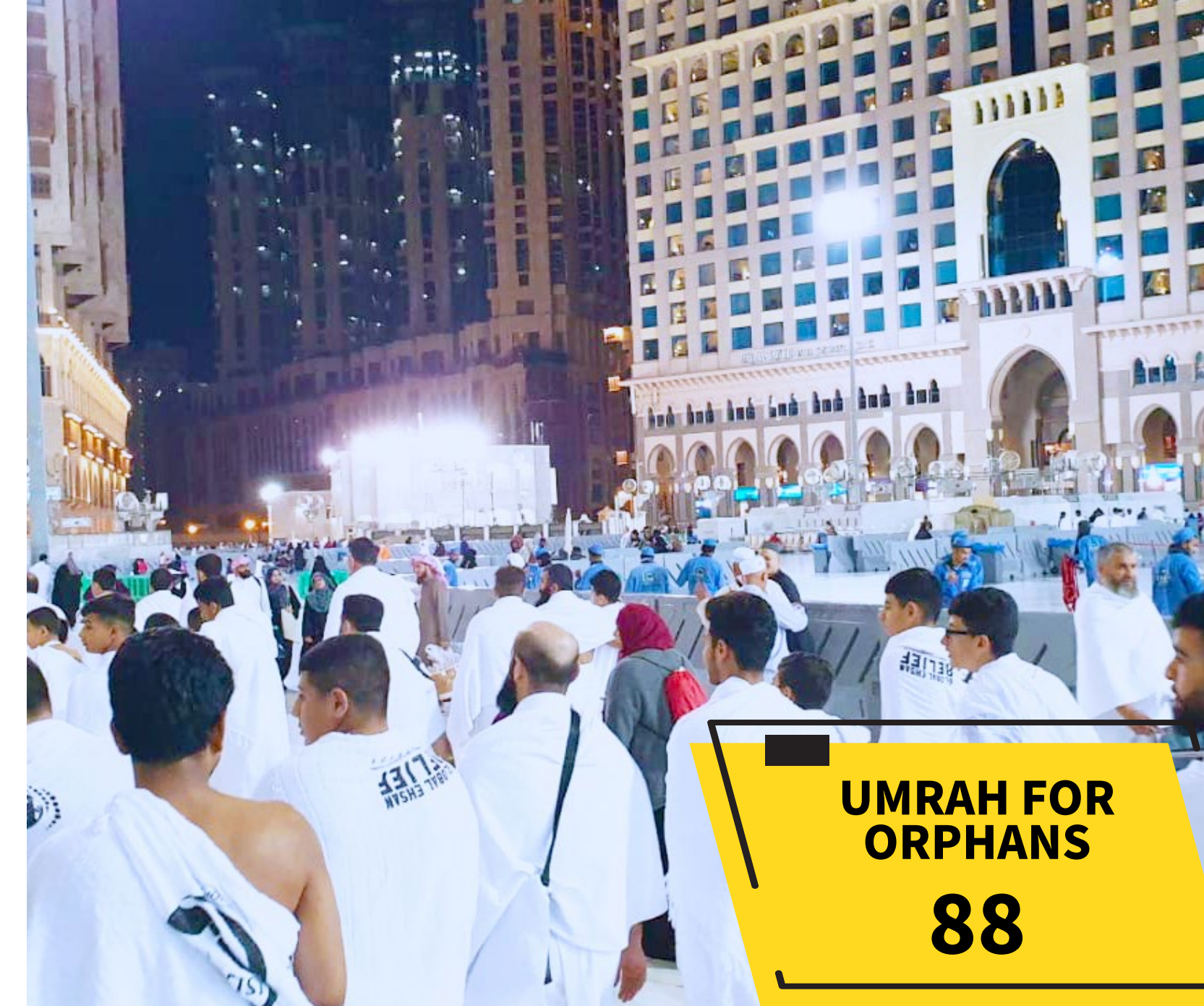
Every child deserves happiness. Orphans, especially, need quality care to build a brighter future for themselves. An orphan in Islam is defined as a child who has lost his father or both of his parents. The number of orphans are increasing, and it is very difficult for them to survive on their own without the counsel of a parental figure.

Global Ehsan Relief is committed to bringing quality care to these children by providing them with food, clothing, shelter, medical needs, and education. This year, we exceeded our target of sponsoring 500 orphans. Currently there are a total of 750 orphans in our care, 500 of which are Hifz orphans, and 250 Non-hifz orphans. On top of the basic needs, Hifz orphans also undergo a programme where they can learn and memorise the entire Qur'an.

UMRAH FOR ORPHANS

In January 2020, we brought 88 Palestinian orphans on an Umrah trip in Mecca and Medina. 44 of them were Palestinian orphans who live in Jerusalem, and the other 44 live in Jordan. To be able to perform their umrah is a once in a lifetime opportunity for the orphans, made possible by our kind donors.

CARE FOR HUNGER

FOOD AID SETS

Food aid packs are much-needed assistance for those living in developing countries, especially in rural parts where food is hard to come by. This food assistance we distribute consists of non-perishable food items that can sustain a family of 5-7 for 2 to 4 weeks, thus easing their financial burdens and removing their worries about not having anything to eat.

Our Ehsan Food Hamper in Singapore aims to provide food aid to underprivileged families living in a thriving, urban country. There are people who are struggling to make ends meet in this metropolis. In 2020, Global Ehsan Relief distributed 6,383 food aid packs in countries such as Cambodia, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, and Singapore.

MEALS

On top of food aid packs, we have also distributed 8,938 meals altogether by our GER offices. The distributions of these meals were part of various projects done by our offices such as Food Car, Share-A-Biryani, and Share-A-Meal in Indonesia, Sri Lanka, and Singapore respectively.

World hunger is on the rise. 690 million people in the world go to bed on an empty stomach each night. Our Care For Hunger programmes are implemented so we can do our part to combat world hunger, and feed those that we can.

CARE FOR EDUCATION



BACK TO SCHOOL

Every child deserves an education, and they deserve the right tools to maximise their learning. However, education can be costly. Expenses to procure education materials may be too much for poor families to bear.

In 2020, we distributed 245 sets of school supplies to less fortunate children in different countries. The sets include school bags, notebooks, stationery, and even school shoes.

200 sets were distributed to students from Kanthale and Kinniya in Trincomalee district, Sri Lanka. 45 sets were distributed in Singapore at the end of December 2020 to ensure students are well-equipped for the new school year.

CARE FOR CLEAN WATER

WATER WELLS

Developing countries face many challenges. Poverty, famine, and drought brings about a severe shortage of clean water for drinking and sanitation purposes. 2.1 billion people globally lack access to clean water. 159 million drink directly from open contaminated sources of water. To address this problem, Global Ehsan Relief builds waterwells for a household of 1-3, built as a hand pump so they have easy access to clean water right within their homes. A total of 755 water wells were built in 2020, benefitting a total of 3775 people in Cambodia, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, and Pakistan.

ABLUTION PLACES

Ablution places are crucial in mosque compounds to ease the process of taking wudhu for the congregation. On top of that, they can also be used for other purposes such as providing drinking water and giving life to flora and fauna that beautify the mosque. A total of 127 ablution places were built in 2020 - 77 in Cambodia, 50 in Sri Lanka.

GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS

1. BUILDING OF MOSQUES

Building a wakaf mosque is one of the greatest acts of sadaqah jariyah. A mosque provides communities with a place of worship, offering education and essential community services. For as long as the mosque is being utilised by the community (and it can last many years), you share in its rewards. We managed to raise funds to construct 15 mosques. In 2020, we included more African countries in our portfolio, where mosques are needed in many rural villages. These mosques were built in Cambodia, Aceh, Tanzania, Cameroon, Mali, Mozambique, Chad, Uganda and the Central African Republic (C.A.R).

2. MOSQUES REFURBISHMENT

Besides constructing new mosques, we undertook refurbishment projects of 4 mosques in Aceh that have seen wear and tear. Despite their conditions, residents of the villages still attend congregational prayers at their respective mosques. This refurbishment project allowed them to attend prayers and other mosque activities in comfort. Al-Kazeem, Riyadhushalihin Mosque, Sumber Mukti Mosque and An-Nur Mosque were successfully refurbished and benefitted a total of 960 muslim villagers.

GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECTS

3. QUR'AN

Global Ehsan Relief provides wakaf Qur'an to people in poor communities whose knowledge of the Qur'an and Islam are minimal due to lack of resources. Wakaf Qur'an is another form of sadaqah jariyah that can reap many rewards to the benefactor.

A total of 9,196 wakaf Qur'an (1,000 of which are iqra' books) were distributed in 2020 in the following countries: Sri Lanka, Mali, Gambia, Syrian Refugees, Kenya, Myanmar, Uganda, and Indonesia. Because of this wakaf, 9,196 young individuals are now active learners of the Qur'an.

4. QUR'AN BRAILLE DIGITAL

Wakaf Qur'an Braille aims to assist those who are visually impaired to read, learn, and memorise the Qur'an. There are more than 6,000 blind Muslims living in Indonesia alone, and nearly all of them are living in poverty. 179 Qur'an Braille were distributed to institutions attended by visually-impaired students who can now benefit from these contributions.

Yemen, Gaza and Syria have been facing prolonged conflict. Its people have had to bear severe consequences - displaced from their own homes. As a result, they suffer extreme food, water, shelter, and medical shortages.

This is largely due to the disruptions in supply chains as borders are restricted by the authorities. With the help of our donors, we continue to provide aid to the people suffering in these regions as they fight to survive each day.

They live in makeshift shelters that are not built to protect its occupants against freezing temperatures. They face a shortage of food that worsens their state of hunger in this cold season.

The Southeast region of Asia experiences a monsoon period from time to time. For developing countries, this poses a problem as they do not have the infrastructure to prevent flooding.

When flooding emergencies occurred in 2020, Global Ehsan Relief responded by providing aid to the flood victims in Indonesia and Cambodia. The aid consisted of food packs, hygiene kits, prayer tools, and baby needs.

LEBANON

After the explosion that occurred in Lebanon in August, the public came together to help as much as they could. With the help of supporting donors and partners on the ground, the following aid were distributed to the homeless - families whose homes were severely devastated and unable to meet their basic needs.

PAKISTAN

In August 2020, Pakistan was plunged into chaos as floods inundated the streets of Karachi. Many were affected by the floods, losing their homes and belongings. In response to this disaster, we distributed 1,000 hot meals and 500 clothes to ease their troubles during this period.

BANGLADESH

Bangladesh also experienced monsoon floods, followed by a super-cyclone. More than 9 million people were affected, further worsening the conditions of the Bangladeshis. 400 food aid packs were distributed in Dimla Village, Nilphamari District, benefitting 2,000 people.

2020 was a unique year, to say the least. The whole world came to a standstill when the COVID-19 pandemic forced us to stay home, causing school closures and even unemployment.

The global supply chains were interrupted, rendering food and other basic needs inaccessible to some. Our COVID-19 Emergency Relief aimed to ease these troubles, and provide those needs. Among the aid delivered were food aid, meals, hygiene kits, blankets & mattresses, face masks/shields and hand sanitizers.

This pandemic also brought about the Ehsan Hardship Fund project by GER Singapore, providing cash assistance and grocery vouchers to families who have been affected by the lockdown.

IFTAR MEALS DISTRIBUTION

Iftar has always been one of the ways to feed the Muslim community in the blessed month of Ramadhan. Due to the support from donors and partners, a total of 18,294 iftar meals have been distributed in 12 countries.

SAHUR MEALS DISTRIBUTION

Meals to start the day during Ramadhan is crucial, especially for the Muslims who are in total lockdown. A total of 350 meals were distributed to 350 migrant workers at Marina South Dormitory in Singapore.

FOOD AID DISTRIBUTION

A month's supply before Ramadhan would ease the lives of the refugees, and most vulnerable communities. 5,512 food aid sets were distributed in various countries. The food aid is different for each region, and each food aid set can feed a family of five and will last them throughout Ramadhan.

PRAYER CLOTHES DISTRIBUTION

In some rural areas, prayer garments may not be easily accessible for the Muslims. A total of 250 individuals received a set of prayer clothes last Ramadhan. 100 sets were distributed in Cambodia, and another 150 in Aceh, Indonesia.

ZAKAT DISTRIBUTION

Zakat serves as a way to purify one's wealth. It is also one of the five pillars of Islam, and highly encouraged to do in Ramadhan. Muslims whose savings meet or exceed certain values are obliged to give 2.5% of their annual savings to the poor and needy and for the welfare of the Muslim community. Global Ehsan Relief has successfully raised for 120 zakat beneficiaries in Aceh and 100 beneficiaries in Gaza.

EID MEALS & GIFTS DISTRIBUTION

Meal time creates perfect bonding, especially during a joyful day. A total of 680 meals were given out to the most needy families in Singapore, in the morning of Eid Fitri. A gift can come in many forms. As for the refugees and most needy, even the smallest gift says everything. A total of 555 sets of various gifts were provided for them during Eid.

QURBAN RELIEF 2020

The Qurbani program in 2020 was Global Ehsan Relief largest ever. A total of 4,295 animals were sacrificed and their meat distributed to poor Muslims families in 33 different countries. Over 290,000 beneficiaries benefitted from the donors' contributions. The blessings of Eid reached the poor, the orphaned and the displaced. For many of them, it was the first time that they were able to enjoy meat that year.

IFTAR MEALS

Everyone deserves to celebrate on the days of joy in Islam. With the support of the partners on the ground and donors, a total of 800 iftar meals were provided to the people in Gaza.

EID ADHA GIFTS & MEALS

Eid Adha is yet another festive season celebrated by Muslims all around the world. Donors have extended their joy to others by providing meals. 300 meals were distributed to the most needy in Gaza, which benefitted 1,500 people and 10,000 meals were distributed to the refugees in Rohingya camps. Spreading joy to another Muslim far away is possible with Global Ehsan Relief. Due to the donors' kindness, 100 children received an eid gift each. These gifts mean a lot to the children who have been through so much since young.

NEW PROJECTS

HEALTHCARE - EHSAN MATERNITY WARD @ TANZANIA

In northeastern Tanzania, Tanga, the construction of the Mlalo Health Centre in the district of Lushoto was completed. The population in Lushoto are among the poorest in Africa - with 80% of them living on less than \$50 a month. This means they are unable to seek medical attention as and when they require.

Over the years, this resulted in high mortality rates for women and children. The completion of this ward means 45 patients can be served a day. This totals up to 16,200 patients a year who are able to receive the care and treatment they need for free. It is our hope that this maternity ward will benefit generations of mothers and children to come.

CARE FOR CLEAN WATER - COMMUNITY WATER WELLS

263 million people spend hours a day just to collect water. In Cambodia, where access to clean water is scarce, we built 91 community water wells. Each community water well can benefit 10-15 families, and supplies clean water for 10 years or more. With the ease of a water well in their village, they no longer have to walk for hours to find water for drinking, cleaning, and more.

MISSION OF HOPE

Mission of Hope was successfully executed a few times before the lockdown happened. During the 3-days trip together with some volunteers, a musollah was refurbished, and an orphanage was cleaned. Also, 30 food aid sets were distributed to the most needy villagers in Batam, Indonesia.

CHARITY RIDE TO CAMBODIA

In a self-initiated project by Jalan-jalan Junkie, a charity ride was organised and carried out. This charity ride involved a group of motorcycle riders from Singapore who fundraised for various projects in Cambodia. Food Aid Sets, Stationery Kits, Ice Cream for Kindness Day and Clothes were distributed to 1,000 poor villagers. Soccer Clinic was conducted which benefitted 30 children.

HIKE FOR ORPHANS @ MOUNT MUNTAHAK

Hiking is one of the ways to appreciate nature. The first hike was organised and implemented successfully by GER Malaysia. A total of 12 participants took part in the hike at Mount Muntahak, Kota Tinggi, Malaysia. This hike was in support of the international project, Care for Orphans. Proceeds were channeled towards the orphans and their daily needs.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM @ ACEH

With our annual Community Involvement Program (CIP), dedicated volunteers are developed. Together with the Global Ehsan Relief team in Aceh and the volunteers, 7 activities were conducted. The picnic with orphans involved and benefitted 95 sponsored orphans. Volunteers also managed to teach simple English Language to 88 students in a school, distributed 400 ice cream during Kindness Day, refurbished a mosque, provided 65 gifts for the elderly in old folks home, and lastly, gave out 310 food aid sets which benefitted 1,550 people.

LIVELIHOOD PROJECT @ CAMBODIA

This project aims to provide beneficiaries with the tools to sustain themselves. Besides providing much-needed aid, we hope to provide them with the means to earn their livelihood. Fishing nets were given to 5 individuals in the Takeo province, Cambodia. They are fishermen whose lack of resources prevent them from earning more than they possibly could.

01/ SCHOOL FOR SYRIAN REFUGEE CHILDREN (Mafraq, Jordan)

Providing classrooms and education facilities to about 50 -100 Syrian refugee children who have been deprived of school due to conflict.

02/ SCHOOL IN A BUS (Bekaa Refugee Camp, Lebanon)

To provide quality education and support to 104 Syrian refugee children living in the Beqaa camps - converting a bus into a mobile classroom
