# CARE FOR ORPHANS

Orphans are very important to Global Ehsan Relief. The Orphan Sponsorship is a vital lifeline for many vulnerable young children. Other than providing food, shelter and clothing, our sponsorships are also supporting the children's education and medical care.

Alhamdulillah, we now have over 1,100 orphans under our care - with 704 of them under our Hifz Orphan Sponsorship Program - who are also studying to memorise the entire Quran.

One of them is Satria Rahmadania, a 13-year-old orphan from Aceh, Indonesia. He has been under our Hifz Sponsorship program for the past two years and alhamdulillah he has managed to beautifully recite the verses from the Quran.

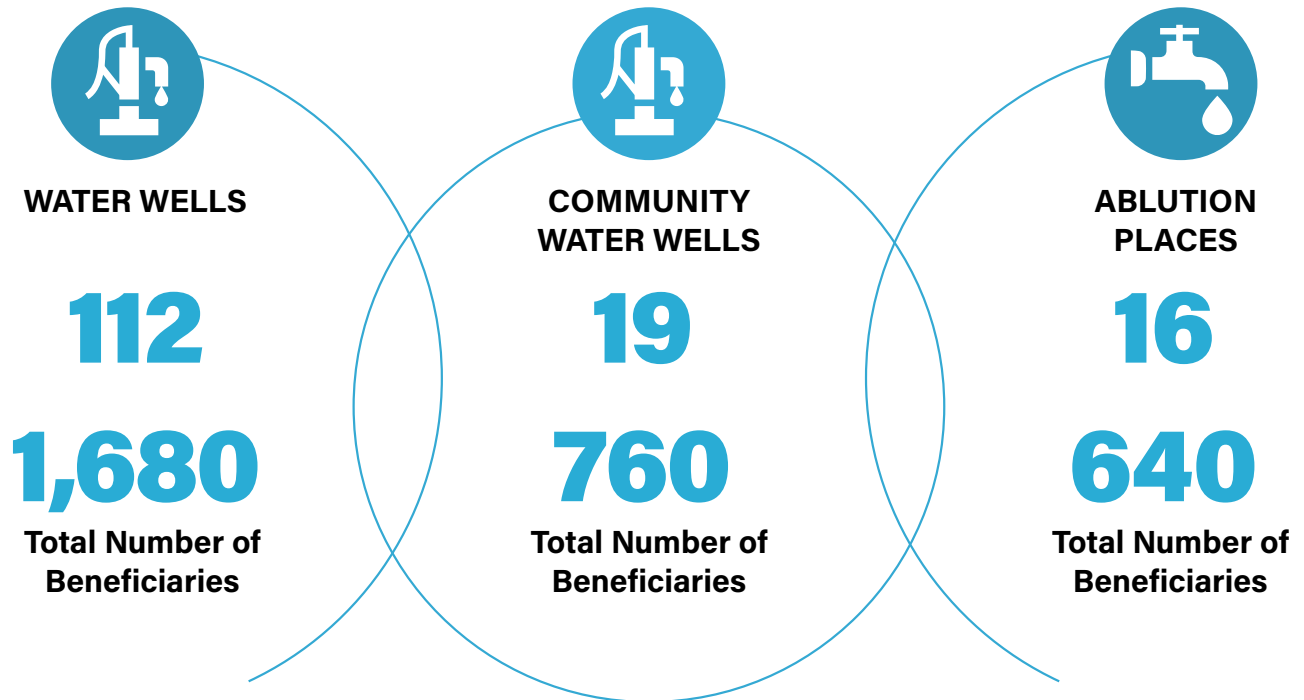

# CARE FOR CLEAN WATER

Since 2016, GER has helped build over 3,000 Water Hand-pumps, 260 Community Water Wells and 150 Ablution places in five countries - helping an estimated **40,000** people in needy and rural areas have access to clean water.

During our team's CIP trip to Cambodia recently, they visited Takeo Province to see the impact of GER's water projects and visited the communities that have benefitted tremendously from the installation of the Community Water Wells. While in the past they had to buy the water or walk for miles to collect water for their daily needs, now these wells have helped them to save time and save lives. Now these families are able to get clean water for their cooking, bathing, ablution, washing and feeding their livestock.

Thus far, GER has built over **200** Community Water Wells and more is needed.





With the support of our GER community, more ablution places were built in Battambang, Tboung Khmum and Kampong Cham provinces in Cambodia, as well as in the needy communities in Sri Lanka. With the construction and completion of these new Ablution Places, the community there now have a proper place to take their ablution for prayers at the masjids or home, benefitting hundreds.



# GLOBAL WAKAF PROJECT

## WAKAF MOSQUE CONSTRUCTION

Alhamdulillah over the past three years, we have helped build **40 mosques in 10 countries**. In the first quarter of 2022, we managed to build four more mosques in different parts of the world.

In February, our first masjid for our Syrian brothers and sisters was completed. Masjid Ar-Rayyan was built with funds raised by our GER community, through our special Mosque Prayer Space project, where anyone could contribute \$100 for one wakaf prayer space.

With the support of 500 donors, Masjid Ar-Rayyan is able to serve 3,000 families in the Deir Hassan district. It is built right in the middle of our Shelter Project for Displaced Syrian Refugee Families who had fled the conflict and previously were staying in tents. Now, they have a brick home in a sheltered compound provided by our partners in Turkey, which also includes a school, clinic and a community kitchen.

Masjid Ar-Rayyan is built on top of a hill overlooking the compound and is the **only masjid** where these families can do their prayers. There is also a Quran Teaching Centre at the mosque, which is still in the midst of renovations.

Over in Cambodia, we celebrate the opening of three new beautiful mosques in three different villages. Our mosques come with a complete package, providing the salary for the costs of Imams and Quran teachers who will conduct Islamic and Al-Quran classes for the villagers. This allows the community, especially the women and children, to receive vital religious education.

# GLOBAL EMERGENCY APPEAL

## YEMEN

As we are all aware, Yemen is currently facing its worst humanitarian crisis. Half of its population are living in poverty, with almost two million children facing acute malnutrition.

Our Yemen Emergency Aid continued in March. With our partners on the ground, we found out that another major problem faced by the community is the lack of access to clean, drinkable water. As a result of the conflicts in the country, most infrastructure was damaged or no longer functional.

With the help of our partner Islamic Help, we were able to provide 14 truckloads of clean water to 70 vulnerable families in Sana'a, Yemen.

Water is the gift of life and together with our GER community, we are providing a vital source of life to these dire communities, who still face the threat of starvation and uncertainty daily.

# GLOBAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

## EMERGENCY FLOOD RELIEF

As we are all aware, Yemen is currently facing its worst humanitarian crisis. Half of its In January, In January, heavy torrential rains continued with intensity in the Southeast Asia region, affecting countries like Malaysia and Indonesia.

In Aceh Utara, Indonesia, over 30 villages were underwater, displacing 3,000 families who were evacuated to relief centres.

Our GER Indonesia Team, with the help of volunteers, provided relief with their Emergency Flood Relief distributions and helped to distribute vital aid to 10 villages affected by the flood. Each village consisted of 100 families, with our aid helping more than 1,000 families in total.

Our team accessed the affected areas and delivered basic needs using rubber boats facilitated by the local leaders.

Each village received:

- Rice (7.5kg)
- Cooking Oil (12L)
- Eggs (150)
- Instant Noodle (4 Boxes)
- Mineral Bottle (10 Boxes)
- Biscuit (12 Packs)
- Baby Diapers
- Ready-To-Eat Meals

Several community kitchens were also set up at various points, with volunteers helping to cook and deliver the meals to the affected communities.

# GLOBAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

## SNOWSTORM

In January, a snowstorm devastated parts of Lebanon, and heavy snow blanketed the **Bekaa and Aarsal Valleys**, the areas where most of the Syrian refugee camps are located. This caused temperatures to fall below zero, damaged many homes and disrupted supplies of basic and crucial necessities to the camps.

With the help of our partners who braved the extreme weather to reach the refugee camps, we were able to provide relief and vital emergency aid. Among the items provided were: food aid packs, blankets, and fuel for heating at the Sanabal and Syuhadah refugee camps.

There was also another team located in Northern Syria to provide relief there.

# SEASONAL PROJECTS

## EHSAN RAMADHAN 2022 - RAMADHAN FOOD AID PACKS

Alhamdulillah we are blessed to be able to welcome yet another Ramadhan.

Ramadhan is a time for worship and giving. While so much around us feels uncertain, we can feel safe in the promise of Allah S.W.T, the Most Generous, that giving charity can not only help change the lives of millions living in poverty worldwide, but also multiply our rewards during the blessed month.

For Ehsan Ramadhan 2022, we call upon our community worldwide to support those in need by providing food to feed the hungry, perform wakaf to help the poor and give hope to those who have lost their homes, livelihoods and loved ones over the past year.

In total, we have provided food aid to as many as **35 countries around the world**, working together with our partners, volunteers and staff on the ground to deliver essential food aid packs to communities who are in dire need of assistance. In total, we have helped more than **24,000 beneficiaries**.

For instance, our GER Indonesia team distributed 200 food aid packs to residents in Kampung Blang Dalam, Aceh Jaya. The kampung is located more than 50 kilometres from the main road, making the village extremely isolated and underdeveloped.

More than 90% of the village's population work as daily paid farmers on a palm plantation. Surrounded by palm trees, the village is extremely dry, and has a higher temperature compared to other villages.

This is the first time the village has received food aid packs to last an entire month, and they are extremely grateful for it!

# MISSION TRIP

## COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT PROGRAME, CAMBODIA

Kampot Province, Takeo, Kampong Cham, and Kratie Province

From 11th to 16th February, our team from Singapore - including our CEO, Basheer Ahmad, were in Cambodia for a CIP trip to oversee the projects implemented.

On their first day of activities, they drove to Kampot Province, a three-hour drive from the capital. They witnessed the opening and handing over of GER's 14th masjid built in Cambodia.

Masjid Abdullah is a medium-size mosque that will benefit the community living there. While there, the team distributed food aid packs, sejadah and praying tools to the most needy families.

They also carried out a Kindness Day programme, where they gave sweets, chocolates and ice-cream to the group of children who had gathered there.

The team also attended the opening of Masjid Hjh Jameela, supported by donors from Singapore. The community there were so excited by their visit and even prepared a grand reception, where 200 children lined up the streets to greet the team with nasheed.

The team distributed food aid sets, prayer tools, stationery sets and had our trademark Kindness Day.

# MISSION TRIP

During the trip, the team had the pleasure of visiting our third madrasah – Ma'Had Al-Ehsan. It is our first madrasah built as a community, meaning it was built with the support of over 200 donors. Ma'Had Al-Ehsan will provide education to an estimated 70 students in the remote village of Phnom Pi.

One important focus of the trip was to oversee our **Care for Clean Water projects**. The team visited several villages to oversee how our GER Cambodia team implemented the projects from start to finish.

The team tested out our manual water hand-pumps that we have been providing all these years and they found out that it was difficult to manually pump water out, especially during the dry season.

Due to this, GER has opened up the opportunity for people to build Electric Water Wells. Through this, the team on the ground will install electrical motor pumps to the wells to make things easier for our beneficiaries. With just a switch, they can get access to buckets of clean water for their families and neighbours - all without having to manually pump the water out.

## GER SINGAPORE MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION

Our GERSG team has managed to continue supporting our beneficiaries in Singapore throughout the first three months of 2022.

With our evergreen partner Chapalang Brotherhood Bikers, our monthly distributions have managed to touch the lives of our beneficiaries and leave a positive impact on them.

Each month, our teams are sent to the same households to ensure that we are able to better assess the beneficiaries when we meet them every month. We pray that we are able to assist our beneficiaries better in the coming months.

Beneficiary of Build A Mosque Project



I am a Masjid leader in Sen Jom Village, O-Angkonh Commune, Sontong District, Kampong Thom Province. My name is Lee Kriya, 42 years old. Before the masjid was constructed, we all struggled since some of us do not have vehicles. Even for those who had vehicles, the hot weather and bad road conditions made it difficult for them to reach the masjid.

Furthermore when it rained heavily, their wives at home are worried and anxious as a result of their husbands' having to travel in the rain. The walk to the previous masjid is around four kilometres long. Of course, we are willing to go but our wives who stay at home are frightened.

The major issue is during Ramdhan, we need to perform Tarawih prayers and our homes are located far from the masjid. Therefore this makes it difficult for us. After Masjid Bidah Unang was constructed, we are all delighted because now there is a masjid constructed near us, so we are extremely happy.
